

Rudyard Lake

Topbond have recently completed a £300,000 Penstock Replacement project at Rudyard Lake in Leek, Staffordshire.

Rudyard Lake is a 200 year old listed lake built originally in the late 1700's by the Engineer John Rennie for the Trent and Mersey Canal Company to feed the Caldon canal system.

Topbond were engaged to remove the existing Penstock and install a new hydraulically operated penstock. The works comprised of underwater concreting, cutting and diamond drilling in zero visibility to high tolerances the works were completed within a tight timescale. Topbond also carried out enclosed spaces inspection and repairs to the structures and M&E systems, tunnels, culverts and valve tower using our skilled Engineers, Masons and Carpenters.



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
