Health and Safety Policy Statement

We will ensure we have effective arrangements in place to undertake work safely and prevent injury, ill health or damage to the environment.

The directors recognise that if the objectives of this policy are to be achieved the commitment of all persons in the company is required. Therefore, procedures for communicating about, and consulting with, employees on such matters are built into the policy.

Health & Safety will not be compromised for any other objectives.

The Company will work within Network Rail Group and Company standards whilst undertaking works on the Network Rail Infrastructure. We will also work within the IJUBOA code of practice & comply with the ISM standards required.

The overall and final responsibility for the implementation of this policy rests with the Managing Director, who will ensure that the policy and associated procedures are formally reviewed annually. Where opportunities for improvement are identified, procedures will be amended. All such amendments will be brought to the attention of all persons concerned.

This Policy and its objectives are facilitated by virtue of the operation of an OH&S Management System that is assessed and certified to the ISO:45001 standard and which forms the basis of continuing improvement of the company's occupational health and safety performance and its supporting management systems over time.
